Thank you again for supporting your local ecosystem!


We want to extend a huge thank you to all the amazing volunteers who joined us at the Pollinator Garden this past Saturday!

Make a difference this year with the Coast Fork Willamette Watershed Council's Youth Conservation Crew (YCC)!

The Youth Conservation Crew is a seasonal program that takes place each year from June to August, open to individuals between the ages of 16–20.

The Youth Conservation Crew was founded in 2018, with the purpose of providing local youth with on the job training alongside natural resource professionals. This seasonal program is designed to promote the stewardship of community resources while preparing our youth for future success in a variety of ways.

Work alongside natural resource professionals and receive on-the-job training and education. The 2025 season runs from June 23rd through August 28th and will be accepting applications until April 30th.



The training takes place on April 11, 2025, at 9:00 a.m. at Alton Baker Park in Eugene.




